Our role in processing your data

Data Controller – we have overall responsibility for your personal data.

About the personal data we hold

The main categories of personal data we hold about you are as follows:

- NI Number and DOB
- Employer Details
- Occupation and related Refrigeration Qualification Data

Sensitive Personal Data

The special categories of sensitive personal data that we hold about you are as follows:

Why we are capturing your data

We capture your data so we can undertake the following processing activity:

- Production of Company Certification
- Certification Renewals
- Audits
- Update and Upgrading of Company Membership Details
- Document Archiving
- Regulatory Activity
- Anonymised Labour Studies

Automated decision making and profiling

There isn't any automated decision making or profiling undertaken within the scope of our processing activity.

Our legal basis for processing your data

We need a clear legal basis for capturing and processing your data. For this service this is:

- Contractual some of the services we provide is defined by a service agreement or contract.
- Legal Obligation we are required to undertake some of our processing tasks by law.

Other legitimate interests

There is a legitimate interest in sharing your data within the BESA Group for the purposes of:

- Utilising BESA IT systems for processing activity.
- Utilising BESA Finance systems for processing activity.
- Provision of information on industry matters.
- Making you aware of additional services/schemes provided by the Group.

Who we share your data with

For the purposes specified above, your data will be shared with the following types of organisation.

- Government Departments (Defra and Department of Environment)
- Auditors (appointed by Government)
- Refcom software systems

Sending your data outside the EU / EEA

Personal data is not transferred to a third-party outside of the European Union or European Economic Area.

Our criteria for retaining your data

The personal data will be retained for the necessary time required to deliver this service and in line with relevant legislation for data retention. For the purposes of audit and to support / mitigate any future legal challenges, records will be retained indefinitely. However, we will minimise any non-essential personal data within that archive.

Consequences of not giving us your data

By not providing the required information, we may not be able to deliver the required service.



Your rights

At any point while we are in possession of or processing your personal data, you, the data subject, have the following rights:

Right of access

You have the right to request a copy of the information that we hold about you.

· Right of rectification

You have a right to correct data that we hold about you that is inaccurate or incomplete.

Right to be forgotten

In some circumstances you can ask for the data we hold about you to be erased from our records.

Right to restrict processing

Where certain conditions apply to have a right to restrict the processing.

Right of portability

You have the right to have the data we hold about you transferred to another organisation.

· Right to object

You have the right to object to certain types of processing such as direct marketing.

Right to object to automated processing, including profiling

You also have the right to object to the legal effects of automated processing or profiling.

Your consent

By consenting to this privacy notice you are giving us permission to process your personal data for the purposes identified. Where we are asking you for sensitive personal data we will always tell you why and how the information will be used. You may withdraw consent at any time.

If you have a complaint
